Minutes of meeting held on 12/01/2017 at 3.30 PM in In the Chamber of Director, TTE to discuss the issues relating to equivalence of B.Tech Tool Engg. With Production/Mechanical Engg. at Delhi Institute of Tool Engg (DIET) affiliated with GGSIPU.

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Director, TTE with Director-cum-Principal-DIET and representatives of GGSIP University on 12/01/2017 at 3.30 PM to discuss the issues relating to equivalence of B.Tech Tool Engg. with Production / Mechanical Engg.

At the start of the meeting it was informed by Director-cum-Principal-DIET that though GGSIP University had issued notifications dated 03/12/2014 & 26/10/2015 for granting equivalence between the degrees in Tool Engg. & Mech. Engg. and Tool Engg. & Production Engg., complaints have been received from students that GGSIPU is not honouring its own notifications.

Dr. Pravin Chandra, COE, GGSIPU explained that only AIU can grant equivalence between two different courses. However, GGSIPU will honour its notification for the year 2013-14.

On the query of the Director, TTE whether it was possible to change the nomenclature of the course for the year 2017-18, Director-cum-Principal- DIET replied that for this to happen they will have to first close the course and then start a new course with the new nomenclature with the approval of AICTE.

It was suggested during the meeting that DIET could consider starting B.Tech. in Production Engg. with electives / specialization in various subjects such as Tool Engg. or as an alternative a new course in Production Engg. or Mechanical Engg. could also be started in addition to the existing courses of B. Tech. in Tool Engg. On this suggestion Director-cum-Principal-DIET observed that he would like to hold a meeting with the experts / stake holders in the industry to gauge the requirement of Mech. / Production Engg. etc. before deciding upon the new course to be started.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks to chair.
